FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What textbooks do you use? Can you send me the textbook as an email attachment?

A: The textbook I use in the Accounting 1 video series is discussed very early in Program #1. It is the 20th edition of Fundamental Accounting Principles by Wild, Shaw and Chiapetta. It covers chapters 1-12. It has been told to me that you can obtain e-book access to the textbook we use in the Accounting 1 videos if you go to <http://www.ebook-freee.com/2013/01/ebook-fundamental-accounting-principles.html> (However if that link doesn't work, I can't help you as it is on someone else's website.) The textbook I use in the Accounting 2 video series is discussed very early in Program #201. It is the 21st edition of Fundamental Accounting Principles by Wild, Shaw and Chiapetta. It covers chapters 12-25. I do NOT have any info on a pdf or any e-book I can send you regarding this textbook. However, you might try doing a google search for these textbooks. Or you might try purchasing them on Amazon.com. They have been released for quite a while so you may be able to obtain an inexpensive used copy. I apologize, but I do not have any extra textbook copies I can send to you.

Q: Can I enroll in your class and take it for credit? Can I get an accounting associates degree from you?

A: There are large number of accounting and other classes that JCCC offers for their Associates Degree in Accounting, taught by a variety of instructors. Many of the courses are online.
