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Application Requirements

1. Prerequisite Coursework
2. Nursing prerequisite GPA
3. ATI TEAS scores
4. Certified Nurse Aide
5. Background Consent form
6. Proof of Residency
7. Work History Form



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Prerequisite Coursework

To complete the degree: 27 general education credits are required with at least a grade of C

Must have at least 12 of the general education credits by February 1st

BIOL 144 or BIOL 140 **AND** BIOL 225 must be completed with grades posted at application or you are not considered an eligible applicant

Science courses must have been completed within 5 years of the application deadline*



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General Education Courses

Required at application

- BIOL 144 Human Anatomy & Physiology OR BOTH BIOL 140 Anatomy **AND** BIOL 225 Physiology
- Other required courses to reach at least 12 completed credit hours

Required by fall start date

- ENGL 121 English Composition I
- MATH 171 College Algebra (or higher)
- PSYC 130 Introduction to Psychology

Other courses to be completed for the degree:

- BIOL 227 Human Pathophysiology
- PSYC 218 Human Development

GPA 3.0***

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher in the nursing coursework.

* Average GPA of admitted students is 3.7



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ATI TEAS
Assessment Technologies Institute
Test of Essential Academic Skills


66 minimum score

Available to be completed online or at a testing site

Test must be current within 3 years of application deadline*

Official scores must be received by the Feb 1st application deadline.

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Certified Nurse Aid

- Certification required by February 1st
- Printed proof from Kansas Nurse Aide Registry
- Must be active through the first day of class

There are NO exceptions to this requirement, prior health background or experience does not satisfy the requirement




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CPR for Healthcare Providers

American Heart Association BLS for Health Care Provider CPR is required during summer before the nursing program begins

This is required to be completed before your first day of CNA training




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Previous College Transcripts

All previous college transcripts which include general education courses for nursing are due by Feb 1st

You are responsible for making sure that all transfer credit is showing on your record as equivalent to the required JCCC course names/numbers.


Transcripts will only be accepted directly from the school where you completed the courses.

- Final Ranking is completed




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

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FAQs


If a course is repeated which grade do you accept?
We will take the most recent grade posted on your transcript. If you are currently repeating a class but do not have a grade posted by the application deadline, we will factor the original grade into your GPA. Note – we do not take the highest grade – it is the MOST RECENT grade.

I completed 2 humanities which will count in my GPA?
If more than one course fulfills a requirement, the course with the highest grade will be the one considered.

What is the average GPA and ATI TEAS score of those students admitted?
The average GPA of admitted students is a 3.7.
The average ATI TEAS score is unknown, fall 2022 is the first class with this requirement.

Is there a dress code if I am admitted to the nursing program?
The nursing program has dress code policies that includes no visible tattoos, and natural hair color. If you have a specific inquiry, please reach out to the program director for guidance.

Do I need to do anything in the summer if I am admitted to the RN program?
Some students will need to take courses during the summer, however, the requirements during the summer before nursing classes begin are 1) complete the CPR for healthcare providers 2) attend the TWO mandatory orientation dates. One in June and the other in August. Dates are posted on the nursing website.
