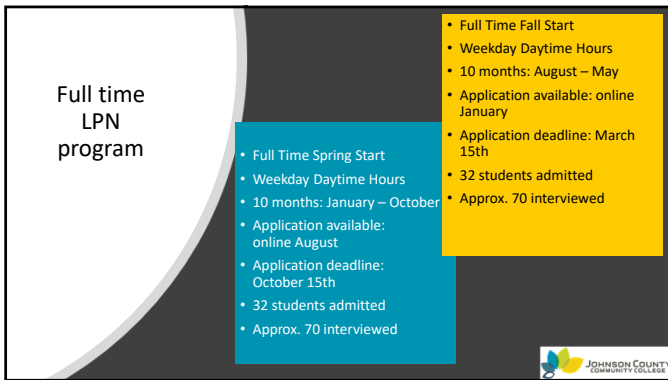
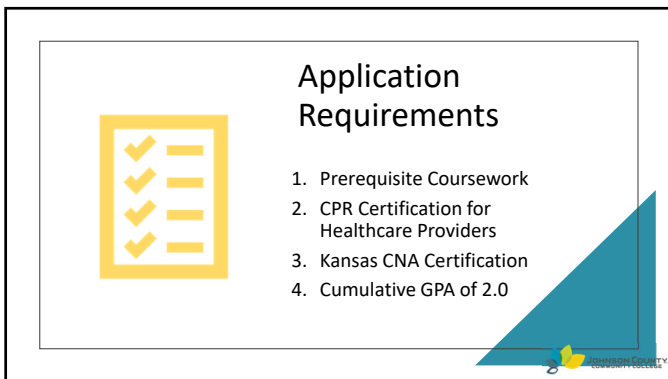

Where are LPN courses taught?
All courses in the program will be at the Olathe Health Education Center, next to Olathe Medical Center.

Do I have to take a test to apply to the LPN program?
There is not an admission test required to apply to the LPN program.

Does this program meet eligibility requirement for students with an F1 Visa?
No, the LPN program does not.

What if I don't pass my PSYC 218 or fail the drug screening?
Final admission to the program is pending completion of all prerequisites, a criminal background check and drug screening.
