




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LPN to RN Bridge program overview

Full time program	Begins in the summer and runs summer, fall and spring semesters	Application available: online October
Application deadline: February 1st	8-12 students admitted	Around 30 applicants each year

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Application Requirements

- Prerequisite Coursework
- Nursing GPA
- ATI TEAS scores
- PN license
- Previous college transcripts
- Background Consent form
- Proof of Residency
- Work History Form
- Current CPR "Health Care Provider" card

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Prerequisite Coursework

-  Must have earned a minimum grade of C in all required courses
-  Must have completed the required general education credits by end of spring semester
-  Science courses must have been completed within 5 years of the application deadline*

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Prerequisite Coursework

- BIOL 144 Human Anatomy & Physiology OR BOTH BIOL 140 AND BIOL 225
- PSYC 130 Introduction to Psychology
- PSYC 218 Human Development
- ENGL 121 English Composition I
- BIOL 227 Human Pathophysiology
- MATH 171 College Algebra (or higher)
- Communications elective (may take fall semester of program)
- Humanities elective (may take fall or spring semester of program)




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NURSING GPA 3.0*

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher in the nursing coursework.

* Average GPA of admitted students is 3.7

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Practical Nursing License

Must have one of the following by June 1st:

- Current PN license
- License pending passing score on NCLEX
- Proof of enrollment in the final semester of LPN program pending passing score on NCLEX by the start of courses




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Previous College Transcripts

All previous college transcripts which include general education courses for nursing are due by Feb 1st

You are responsible for making sure that all transfer credit is showing on your record as equivalent to the required JCCC course names/numbers.


Transcripts will only be accepted directly from the school where you completed the courses.

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Selection Criteria for Interviews

- 40% Nursing GPA
- 30% ATI TEAS score
- 20% A&P grade
- 10% Residency



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- Emails to JCCC account mid-March if selected
- Career Development Center "Interviewing for Healthcare Programs" workshop
- Final Ranking is completed

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FAQs


If a course is repeated which grade do you accept?
We will take the most recent grade posted on your transcript. If you are currently repeating a class but do not have a grade posted by the application deadline, we will factor the original grade into your GPA. Note – we do not take the highest grade – it is the MOST RECENT grade.

I completed 2 humanities which will count in my GPA?
If more than one course fulfills a requirement, the course with the highest grade will be the one considered

What is the average GPA and ATI TEAS score of those students admitted?
*The average GPA of admitted students is a 3.7.
 The average ATI TEAS score is unknown, fall 2022 was the first class with this requirement.*

Is there a dress code if I am admitted to the nursing program?
The nursing program has dress code policies that includes no visible tattoos, and natural hair color. If you have a specific inquiry, please reach out to the program director for guidance.

Do I need to do anything in the summer if I am admitted to the LPN to RN program?
Yes! If admitted to the program you will be required to take NURS 102 Health Assessment and Skills for Nursing Practice and NURS 175 Concepts of Nursing Care during the summer semester. These courses typically begin 2 weeks prior to the regular summer semester.
