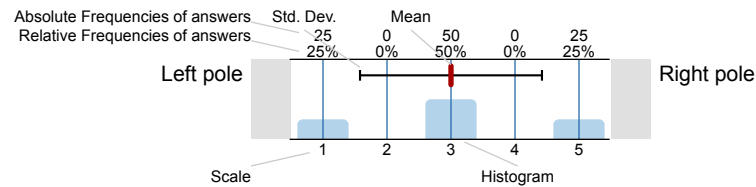

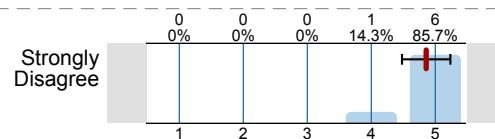

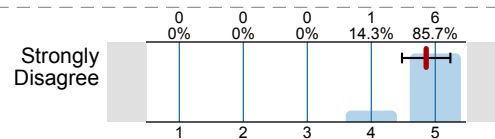

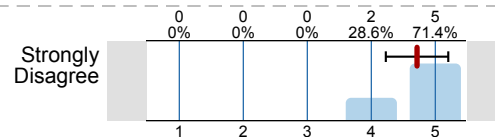

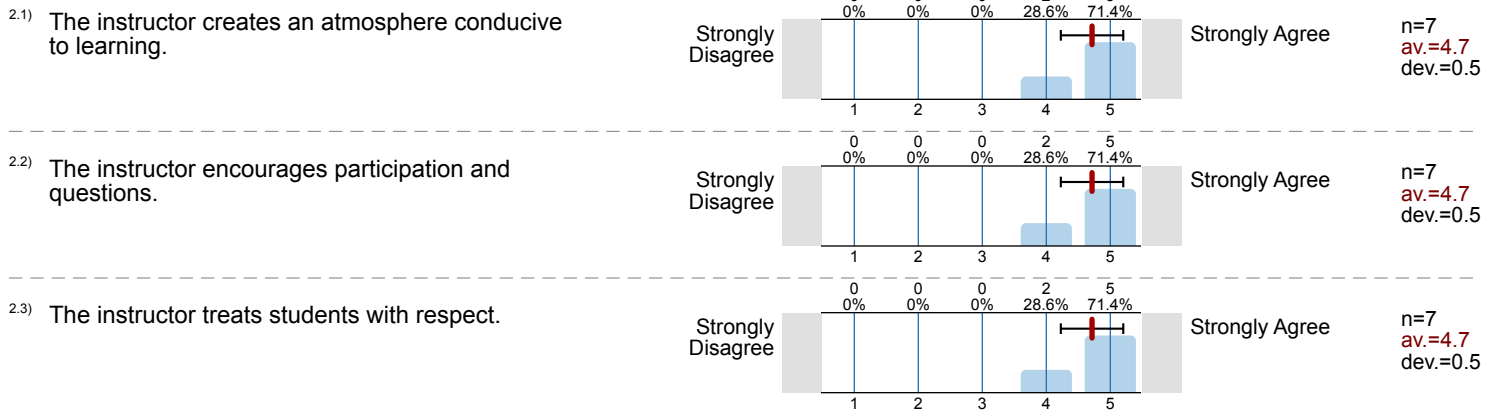

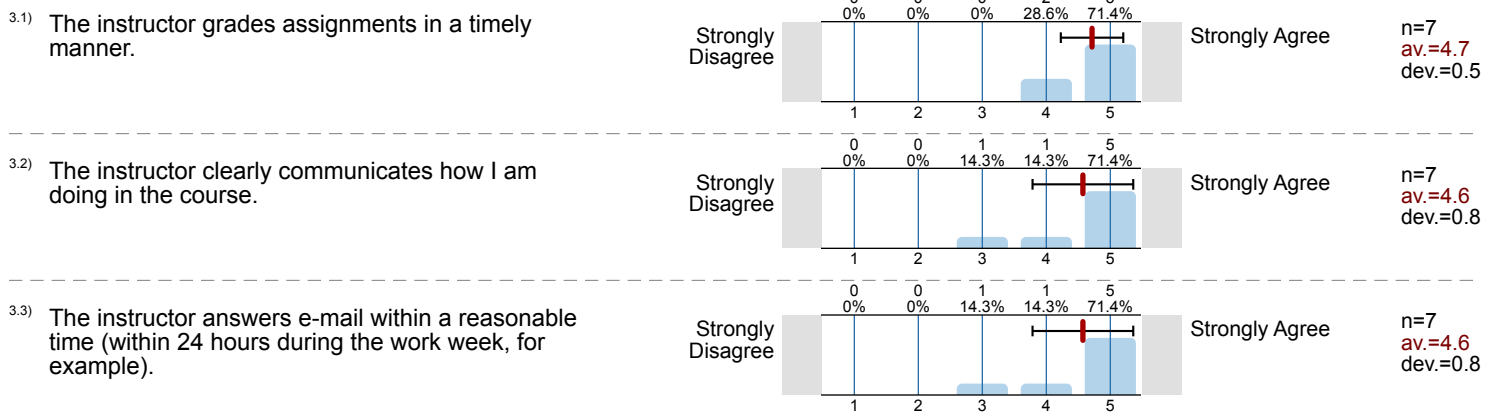

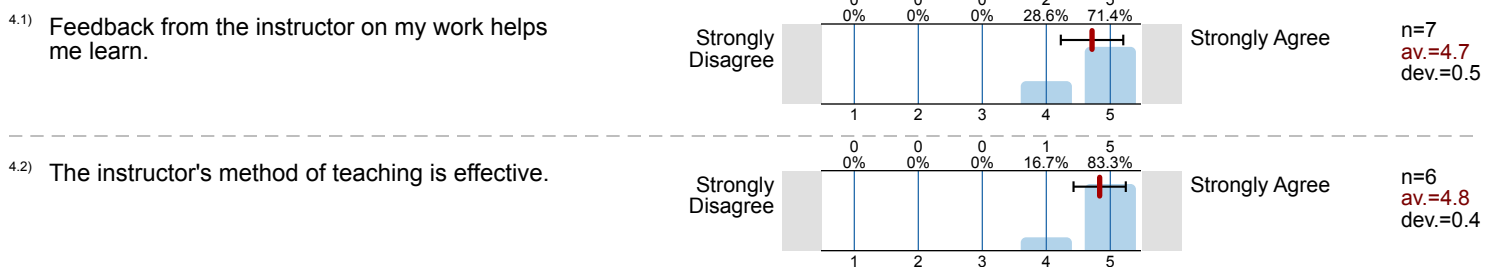

I am very pleased and thankful to say that this was not my experience, and I am so thankful I went with Professor Al-Rawi for this course and will be for future courses as well. Although his accent may be difficult to understand at times, and he isn't one to just give meaningless, quick answers to questions, if you truly care about bettering yourself and learning the material so you can implement it into a future career (which is what I'm trying to do and also changing careers at that), then he is an exception instructor to go with. I am also very thankful that he spends extra time troubleshooting why a lab/homework assignment is not working in class even if it sometimes means not finishing them completely during class time, because taking this extra time to walk through troubleshooting steps and seeing his thought process was key to bettering my understanding. I do wish at times he asked a question during the troubleshooting process and allowed students to try to answer instead of providing the answer immediately, but I also understand that sometimes you can just stand there forever and no one will speak up and that also there's only so much time in class to be utilized, so sometimes he must just proceed with answering the question himself.
