Look at the identification label on the wall. The title might tell you what you need to know, and the interpretive paragraph can help.

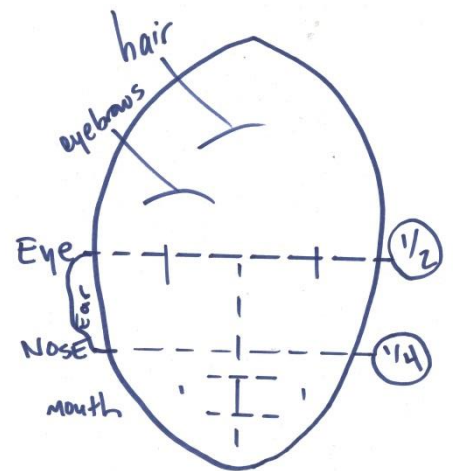
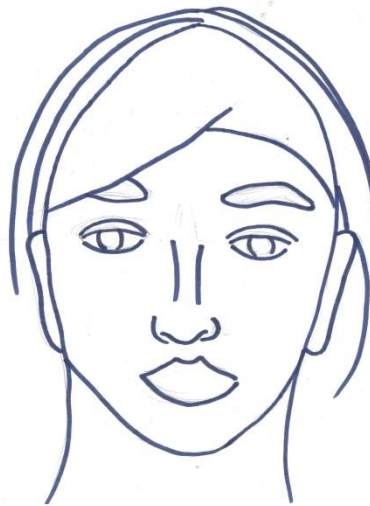
What clothing, accessories, or gestures create the **character**?

What **features** are simplified? What is **exaggerated**?

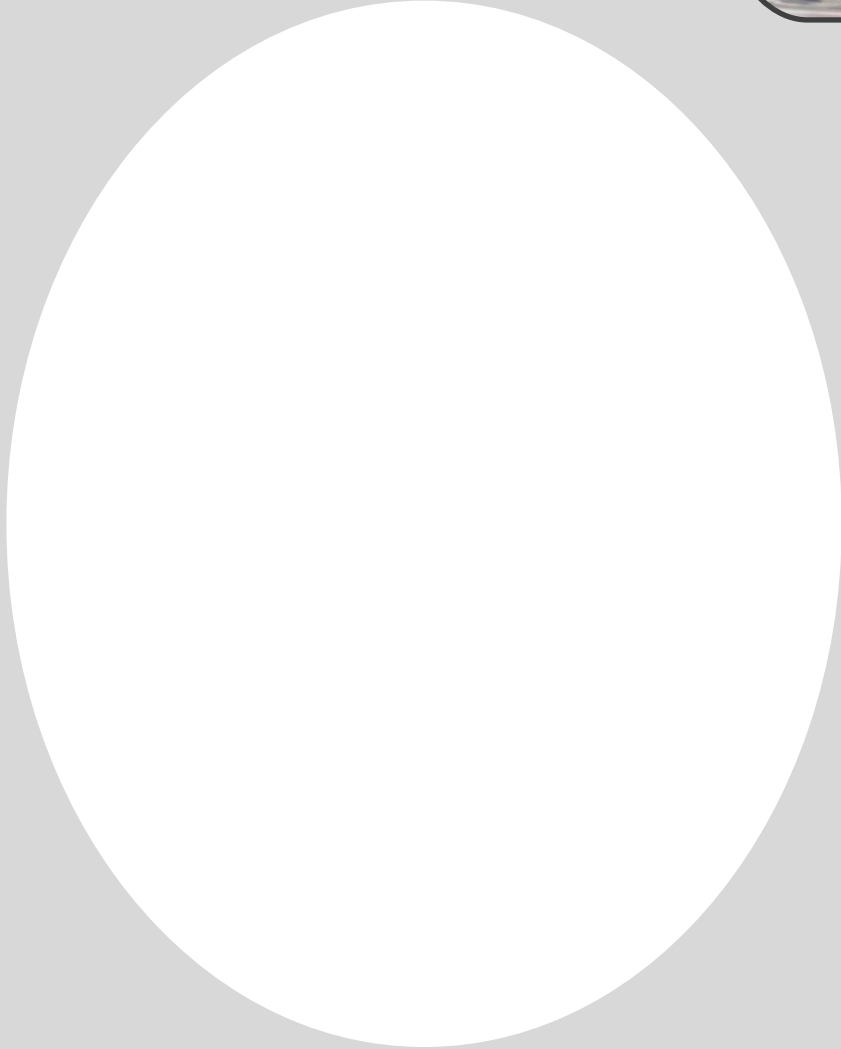
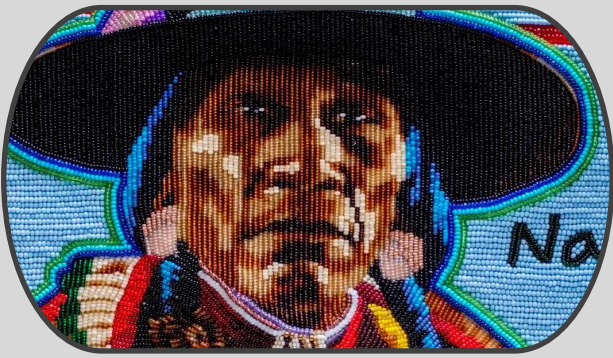
Typical human facial proportions:
